GENERAL

- Prom Information:** If you are planning to attend the Prom, please be aware of the following things:
1-You must have your current RHS ID card to make a purchase AND to enter the dance.
2-If you did not turn in the 2016-2017 dance agreement that was part of the summer mailer, you will not be able to purchase Prom tickets until that form is completed and returned to the Finance Office. If you aren't sure, check the list in the Student Center. If you have lost yours, please see Mrs. Beal in the Student Center or Ms. Cerquettini in the North Campus Office.
3-All RHS Prom Tickets are non-refundable. We will not be able to give you your money back if you do not attend. Please make sure that you can go before you buy your ticket!
If you have any questions, please see Mrs. Beal in the S.C. Activities Office.
- Prom Guest Passes** are now available in the Student Center and the North Campus Office. Completed Guest Pass requests must be turned in to Mr. Ruhm's Office on North Campus for approval before purchasing your tickets. The deadline to have Guest Passes approved is Friday, April 14. If your request is not turned in by 3:00 p.m. on the 14th, we will not be able to approve them. You must bring your approved Guest Pass with you to the Finance Office in order to buy your tickets. You must purchase your guest pass ticket at the same time you purchase your ticket. The last day to purchase guest pass tickets is Wednesday, April 19.
- Prom Attendance.** If you wish to attend the 2017 Prom, please be aware that you must meet the requirements of the RHS Dance Attendance Policy as outlined on the Prom Attendance flyers in your classrooms & on the RHS website. Your 2nd Semester Attendance will be checked before all Prom tickets are purchased. If you have questions about your attendance, or would like to check your eligibility, see Mrs. Beal at lunch in the Activities Office on South Campus. If you have questions or concerns about your attendance, don't wait until the last minute.
- Attention all students!** Money, money, money: Is your account cleared? Do you owe any fees, books, uniforms, previous school fees??? If you are not sure, check the fee list posted outside of the Records Office. The list is posted by student number. Seniors, it is very important that you clear ALL fees as your final transcript and diploma will be held until your account is cleared.
- RHS SUMMER SCHOOL: If you have previously failed a course required for graduation, please make sure to sign up to attend RHS Summer School. Forms are available in the counseling office and must be returned to your counselor on or before April 21. Additionally, if you earned a "D" in a course that is a college pre-requisite, you may retake that course (this does not apply to science and some math courses) this summer during RHS Summer School. Please see your counselor for an application to that program.
- Attention students!** All juniors will be taking the SAT test on Wednesday, April 5th and Thursday, April 6th. Both will be blocked days. On Wednesday you will attend periods 1, 2 and 3. Thursday you will attend periods 4, 5 and 6.
