GENERAL

1. **Prom Guest Passes** are now available in the Student Center and the North Campus Office. Completed Guest Pass requests must be turned in to Mr. Ruhm's Office on North Campus for approval before purchasing your tickets. The deadline to have Guest Passes approved is Friday, April 14. If your request is not turned in by 3:00 p.m. on the 14th, we will not be able to approve them. You must bring your approved Guest Pass with you to the Finance Office in order to buy your tickets. You must purchase your guest pass ticket at the same time you purchase your ticket. The last day to purchase guest pass tickets is Wednesday, April 19.
2. ID Cards: Current ID Cards must be presented for ALL transactions@ the Finance Office windows. This includes Prom Tickets. If you have lost your ID card, you may purchase a replacement for \$5.00 at the Finance Office. Plan ahead, as it may take 24 hours to get a new ID card. No ID card, No tickets.
3. Prom Guest Passes must be turned in to Mr. Ruhm's Office on South Campus for approval by Friday, April 14 at 3:00pm.
4. **Attention all students!** Money, money, money: Is your account cleared? Do you owe any fees, books, uniforms, previous school fees??? If you are not sure, check the fee list posted outside of the Records Office. The list is posted by student number. Seniors, it is very important that you clear ALL fees as your final transcript and diploma will be held until your account is cleared.
5. SUMMER SCHOOL is at Citrus Valley: If you have previously failed a course required for graduation, please make sure to sign up to attend Summer School. Forms are available in the counseling office and must be returned to your counselor on or before April 21. Additionally, if you earned a "D" in a course that is a college pre-requisite, you may retake that course (this does not apply to science and some math courses) this summer during Summer School. Please see your counselor for an application to that program.

All three courses will earn students college credit and all are UC, CSU, and CC transferable, and there is absolutely no cost to students since RUSD is covering all charges. Students will need to attend the Dual Enrollment Application Meeting on Wednesday, April 12th from 3:00-5:00 PM at CVHS in the library in order to begin the registration process for these courses.
