GENERAL

1. ID Cards: Current ID Cards must be presented for ALL transactions@ the Finance Office windows. This includes Prom Tickets. 2. Prom Guest Passes must be turned in to Mr. Ruhm's Office on South Campus for approval by Friday, April 14 at 3:00pm
3. **Attention all students!** Money, money, money: Is your account cleared? Do you owe any fees, books, uniforms, previous school fees??? If you are not sure, check the fee list posted outside of the Records Office. The list is posted by student number. Seniors, it is very important that you clear ALL fees as your final transcript and diploma will be held until your account is cleared.

4. SUMMER SCHOOL is at Citrus Valley: If you have previously failed a course required for graduation, please make sure to sign up to attend Summer School. Forms are available in the counseling office and must be returned to your counselor on or before April 21. Additionally, if you earned a "D" in a course that is a college pre-requisite, you may retake that course (this does not apply to science and some math courses) this summer during Summer School. Please see your counselor for an application to that program.
5. Attention Sophomores & Juniors: If you are interested in being a Link Crew Leader for the 2017-2018 school year, applications are now available in the Student Center. Completed applications must be turned in to the Student Center by 3:00pm on Friday, April 21. Please see Ms. Turnpaugh or Mrs. Beal in the Student Center if you have any questions.

STUDENT CENTER
