GENERAL

1. Attention AP students. The pre-administration session for last names P-Z is today. We will begin at 1:45 in Terrier Hall. You must attend the pre-administration session in order to take your AP tests in May.

2. Students—Roosevelt Street (the road up by the baseball field) will have major construction beginning soon. The City of Redlands will be repaving the road. When this construction begins, please use the main entrance to Terrier gym parking lot off of Church Street.
3. **Prom Information:** If you are planning to attend the Prom, please be aware of the following things:
 1. You must have your current RHS ID card to make a purchase AND to enter the dance.
 2. If you did not turn in the 2016-2017 dance agreement that was part of the summer mailer, you will not be able to purchase Prom tickets until that form is completed and returned to the Finance Office. If you aren't sure, check the list in the Student Center. If you have lost yours, please see Mrs. Beal in the Student Center or Ms. Cerquettini in the North Campus Office.
 3. All RHS Prom Tickets are non-refundable. We will not be able to give you your money back if you do not attend. Please make sure that you can go before you buy your ticket!
If you have any questions, please see Mrs. Beal in the S.C. Activities Office.
4. **Prom Attendance.** If you wish to attend the 2017 Prom, please be aware that you must meet the requirements of the RHS Dance Attendance Policy as outlined on the Prom Attendance flyers in your classrooms & on the RHS website. Your 2nd Semester Attendance will be checked before all Prom tickets are purchased. If you have questions about your attendance, or would like to check your eligibility, see Mrs. Beal at lunch in the Activities Office on South Campus. If you have questions or concerns about your attendance, don't wait until the last minute.
5. **ID Cards:** Current ID Cards must be presented for ALL transactions@ the Finance Office windows. This includes Prom Tickets. If you have lost your ID card, you may purchase a replacement for \$5.00 at the Finance Office. Plan ahead, as it may take 24 hours to get a new ID card. No ID card, No tickets.
6. **Attention all students!** Money, money, money: Is your account cleared? Do you owe any fees, books, uniforms, previous school fees??? If you are not sure, check the fee list posted outside of the Records Office. The list is posted by student number. Seniors, it is very important that you clear ALL fees as your final transcript and diploma will be held until your account is cleared.
7. **SUMMER SCHOOL** is at Citrus Valley: If you have previously failed a course required for graduation, please make sure to sign up to attend Summer School. Forms are available in the counseling office and must be returned to your counselor on or before April 21. Additionally, if you earned a "D" in a course that is a college pre-requisite, you may retake that course (this does not apply to science and some math courses) this summer during Summer School. Please see your counselor for an application to that program.
8. You **MUST** have your current RHS ID card for all transactions at the Finance Office. If you are paying with cash, no large bills over \$20 will be accepted.
9. Auditions for the 2017-2018 Chamber Singers and Les Chanteuses will take place May 1st through May 5th. If you are interested in singing in one of RHS' award winning auditioned choirs, please pick up an audition packet from Mr. Diaz in Room 61. Everything you need to know about the audition process can be found in the packet. Make sure to sign up for a vocal audition time in Room 61 soon, slots fill up fast. Even if you are not currently enrolled in a choir, you are still eligible to audition.
